Welcome to Math 3! Math 3 is where students pull together and apply the concepts that they a have learned from their previous courses; Math 1 and Math 2. Students will apply methods from probability and statistics to draw inferences and conclusions from data. Students will expand their knowledge of functions to include polynomial, rational, absolute value, and trigonometric. Students will continue their study of right triangle trigonometry and expand to trigonometric identities and the unit circle. Students will also use logic and their knowledge of geometric properties to solve proofs; both algebraic and geometric. Upon successful completion of this course, students will be able to take either Pre-Calculus or Discrete Math.

- You should complete the assignments to the best of your ability and it is expected that you ATTEMPT all problems.


